A Certified Hand Therapist (CHT) is an occupational therapist or physical therapist who has a minimum of three years of clinical experience, including 4,000 hours or more in direct practice in hand therapy.

In addition, the Certified Hand Therapist has successfully passed a comprehensive test of advanced clinical skills and theory in upper quarter rehabilitation.







The Recognized Specialist in Hand Therapy

Because of changes in the profession, every CHT is required to demonstrate continued professional development and competency by recertifying every five years.
